2. Candidate should write clearly in ball pen / ink pen.

5. The duration of the examination is 3 hours.
6. Four or more probable answers will be given against each question; only the correct one is to be tick as shown in the example below:

Example: - Yeasts lack:

- a) Nucleus
- b) Chlorophyll
- c) Cell wall
- d) Cytoplasm

7. More than one answer/change of answers / wrong answer / cancellation / overwriting of answer against the question will be deemed as incorrect response and awarded 0(zero) marks.
8. Any candidates appearing in the test may asked for checking his/her marks obtained but not for re-evaluation of answer script on the payment of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only to be deposited at the Directorate of Agriculture under the financial Head and Account to be obtained from the Directorate by filling an application within a period of one week from the date of declaration of result of the test. The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.
10. The examination Centre will open 30 minute before commencement of test and allowed to enter the Exam hall/room 15 minutes before the commencement of the examination. No candidates shall be allowed to the exam hall after 5 minute of the commencement of exam.
12. After receiving the Answer books, the candidates should check the answer books & make sure that it is properly printed and the number of leaves is tallied or does not imprinted or torn or missing. Complaint for any change of Answer Books should be made before writing their Roll Nos & Names on the Answer Books.
13. No candidate should leave the examination hall/room unless permitted by the invigilator to do so.
14. Use of any unfair means by a candidate may lead to immediate expulsion from the examination hall.
15. Candidates should not write their name and roll no. to any part of the answer sheets except in the column provided for the purpose.

16. Candidate should not bring any articles such as books, notes, loose sheets, calculators, Mathematical table, hand bags, cellular phones etc. in the examination hall.
17. The candidates must produce on the demand, the admit card for admission to the examination hall. Candidate who does not possess the admit card issued by the Department of Agriculture, Manipur shall not be admitted to the examination hall.
